APPENDIX 1



COMPETITION INFORMATION

1. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Cadet: Participants must be born from year 2005 - 2012 (13 to 20 years of age)

2. REGISTRATION

Registration should be submitted through respective <u>state associations</u>. Kindly note the <u>deadline for registration</u> submission is on 29th December 2024. A penalty of **RM200/entry** will be imposed on <u>late registrations</u> or <u>withdrawals without</u> acceptable reasons. All payments must be made by <u>one representative only before the</u> <u>start of the competition events</u>. Participation is open to Malaysian citizens and residents only. Points for the National Ranking will only be applicable for Malaysian citizens only.

3. REFEREES

Participating delegations must be accompanied by number of referees according to the FIE Rules as follows :

1 - 4 fencers : 0 referee
5 - 9 fencers : 1 referee / per day
10 or more fencers : 2 referees / per day

All daily expenses for the referees shall be borne by the respective state association solely and not by MFF. If the state association fails to provide the required number of referees, a penalty fee of **RM300.00/per day/per referee** will be imposed.

All referees have to report **1 hour before the start of the first event** they have signed up for in each day of competition and must stay till he/she is released by the Competition Manager. Referees must be attired smartly (no shorts / jeans / slippers).

4. COMPETITION RULES

The fencing competition shall be conducted in accordance with the current statues and rules of FIE. In case of disagreements in interpretation of the rules, the latest FIE rules in the English version shall prevail. The Directoire de' Technique shall deal with any unforeseen incidents not covered by the rules.

5. EQUIPMENTS

FIE equipment is not compulsory, however please be mindful that we MUST follow the listed guidelines below:

- Rusty Weapons are not allowed
- Torn fencing attire is not allowed.
- Black socks and short socks are not allowed
- Inner plastron is compulsory for all fencers/all weapons
- Chest protector with new FIE pad for FOIL is required (female participants need to wear the gender appropriate chest protector for all events)
- For SABER, only gloves with lame will be allowed, overlays are not accepted
- Only transparent mask wire and body wire will be accepted and it must be in good condition.
- Conductive bib for FOIL is a must
- 350N or higher for Jacket and breeches
- FOIL/SABRE Mask are not allowed for EPEE Event

Please be reminded that competitors' equipment can be rejected on the grounds of safety and poor maintenance.

6. EQUIPMENT STANDARDS

The following safety standards are to be followed and will be enforced by the referees:

Item	Minimum Safety Level	Additional Notes
Mask	CE 350N	Mask safety features must be intact and working well
Jacket & Breeches	CE 350N	Jacket and Breeches, when worn, should overlap by an area at least 10cm long all around the trunk of the fencer. Zippers should be facing the non- weapon arm. With accordance to the FIE Rules for Competitions: Fencers' Weapons & Equipment Control Document The fencer must wear, over his jacket, a conductive over-jacket, the conductive surface of which must cover entirely and without omission the valid surface of the body above a horizontal line which, when the fencer is on guard, joins, round the fencer's trunk, the tops of the two hip bones.
Socks	None	Socks should be white and cover the entire shin of the fencer and be overlapped by the Breeches just under the knee. No black socks allowed.
Gloves	None	Gloves should not have obvious holes in them
Metallic Jackets	None	Zippers should be facing the non-weapon arm
Weapons	None	Weapons should not be rusty
Chest Guard	None	Gender appropriate chest protector must be worn.

7. PRIZES

One (1) Gold, One (1) Silver and Two (2) Bronze medals to the top four (4) fencers as well as certificates.

8. ENTRY FEES

Individual Event – RM 160 per person/per event.

Entry fees can be paid by cash only onsite. No payments by card or bank transfer. Kindly be reminded that all fees must be paid before the start of the competition. All payments must be made by <u>one representative only before the start of the competition events</u>. If any of the state representatives would like to make payment online for transactions above RM 4,000. Kindly contact the organisers via email at <u>mffmofc@hotmail.com</u>.

9. SAFETY REGULATIONS

In order to ensure the competition can run smoothly in a safe environment for all participants, MFF kindly ask the co-operation of all those attending to do as follows.

- Participants must maintain a sanitary distance / avoid overcrowding.
- Participants should bring their own bottle of water for sanitary reason.
- Ensure all rubbish / food waste is disposed of before leaving the hall.
- Ensure to keep belongings safely when not supervised.
- For the poule round, all spectators, parents and coaches are to go to Level 4. Only participants are allowed on Level 3 during the poule round.
- Coaches are allowed during the DE but kindly ensure that you are not overcrowding / blocking the competition are for the other players.
- Maintain respect and decorum at all times between fencers, coaches, referees and officials alike.
